- Provide funding for youth related educational and prevention programs such as the County D.A.R.E., (Drug Abuse Resistance Education), S.T.A.N.D., (Somerset Teaming-up Against Narcotics and Drugs), and G.R.E.A.T., (Gang Resistance Education And Training) Programs, Project Graduation, and the Police Academy Youth Week.
